The Annual Kumquat Festival® is a free event, featuring the “Kumquat Growers” located in the Wells Fargo parking lot, where you can learn about and purchase kumquats. The festival includes lots of fun things to see and do.

- Quilt Show around the fountain at the Historic Courthouse from 11am-4pm

The festival is held in downtown Dade City. Parking is also available at various locations just outside of our festival area.
